Message from the Chief . . .

The Year 2006 was an exciting, productive and successful year for the St. John Police Department.

I am pleased to extend my appreciation to many. First and foremost, I thank the members of the St. John Town Council for their support and cooperation this past year. The vision of this administration is most certainly moving the future of the Town of St. John forward in a progressive and positive direction. I thank the St. John Metropolitan Police Commission for their time, effort and dedication provided in the administration of the hiring process for new officers, along with and among various other responsibilities. The entire Police Department, staff and employees of the Town of St. John continue to support all we do with the highest degree of assistance and professionalism. I commend them all for their support and effort.

I respectfully present to the President and to the members of the Town Council, the St. John Police Department Annual Report for 2006. In your review of the report, please note the following highlights:

- Reported crime was down for the third consecutive year by 3%. Reported incidents increased 16%. I attribute this increase in incidents to the continued growth, both residential and commercial, in St. John. Adult arrests increased by 41%; traffic citations increased by 15%.
- The Year 2006 saw the groundbreaking and rise of our new Public Safety Complex, which took place in May 2006. The building had been in the planning stages on paper for about one year. It was a gratifying experience to witness the beginning of the initial construction phase. The facility is well on its way to completion. The projected target date for completion and occupancy of the building is June 2007. Upon completion of the new Public Safety Complex, it will stand as a modern state-of-the-art facility capable of providing the current citizens of St. John with the services which they expect and deserve, and will





TOTAL MILEAGE -- 2002 - 2006






