




YEARLY AVERAGE PER FULL-TIME PATROL OFFICER





INVESTIGATIONS DIVISION - YEAR 2014

In 2014, the St. John Police Department Investigations Division was assigned 73 total cases. Of those total cases, 18 resulted in criminal charges being filed on a suspect(s) with the Lake County Prosecutor's Office, and 2 suspects being arrested. This relates to 25% of the total cases that were assigned to the Investigations Division were closed by either charges being filed and/or actual arrests of the suspects involved in the crimes. Of the 73 total cases, 55 were cases where actual criminal acts of some type were committed by a suspect(s). Of the 55 criminal cases, 33% of those were cases where either charges were filed and/or an actual arrest was made. Several cases assigned to the Investigations Division were resolved by the investigators where criminal charges were unwarranted. In 2013, the Investigations Division was assigned 108 total cases.
