

Approved List of “Parkway” Tree Species-Common Names

Tree Selection Criteria:

1. Relatively disease and insect free
2. Few or no litter problems
3. Non Invasive root systems
4. Drought and salt tolerant

Tree Specifications:

1. 2.5" caliper minimum
2. Straight trunks and lower branches starting at least 60" from the top of the root system

Tree Quantities:

1. Two trees minimum on normal lots. Four trees minimum for corner lots.
 - A. One tree per 75' linear feet of parkway where applicable.

Parkway Placement:

1. Centered in the parkway between sidewalk and street curb.
2. No closer than 30' apart for Parkways.
3. No closer than 50' from STOP signs on the same side of street, if planting in Parkway.
4. Parkways smaller than 75' in linear length may require placement in Homeowners property no closer than 5' from sidewalk (or proposed sidewalk) and no further than 8' from sidewalk.
