

Electronic Recycling Program

The Town of St. John will accept electronics from Lake County, Indiana, residents only at the Public Works facility between the hours of 8 am - 2 pm, Monday - Friday, excluding holidays. Please check in at the front office first and provide your ID. You are responsible for unloading your items and placing them into the bins provided. Please remove your items from any boxes or bags as only electronic items are allowed to be placed in the bins.

If Public Works is closed, PLEASE DO NOT DROP ITEMS OFF AT THE FACILITY.

Please remove ALL batteries from the devices before you drop them off. This includes but is not limited to: remote controls, smartphones, computer tablets, laptops, earbuds, toys, power tools, etc.

Items that will be accepted are as follows:

- Christmas lights
- Cable wire
- Cell phones
- Computers
- Computer cables
- Computer mouse
- Computer monitors
- Computer keyboards
- Dehumidifiers
- DVD players
- Extension cords
- Fax machines
- MP3 players
- PDAs
- Printers
- Radios
- Scanners
- Servers
- Televisions
- VCRs
- Video game consoles
- Zip drives

Items that will NOT be accepted are as follows:

- Automobile tires
- Batteries
- Lamps
- Light bulbs of any kind
- Microwaves
- Vacuums
- Free-flowing liquids (oil, paint, anti-freeze, lubricants, water, etc.)
- Scrap containing residue from hazardous materials/waste such as PCBs, asbestos, cadmium, etc. Some examples of these materials include: automobile air bags, debris containing asbestos, fluorescent light fixtures, ballasts containing PCB.
- Explosives and ammunition of any type
- Corrosive material of any type
- Biological agents, biohazards, poisonous/infectious materials, or raw/spent chemicals
- Pressurized or closed containers (propane tanks, compressed gas tanks/cylinders, aerosol cans, intact/uncut bulk storage tanks, fire extinguishers, etc.)
- Flammable materials (gasoline, kerosene, etc.)
- Radioactive materials of any type
- Medications
